'A Considerable Speck' by Robert Frost

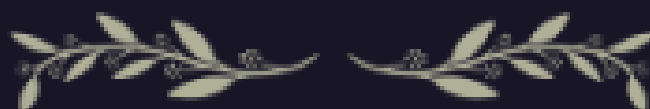
FAVOURITE FICTIONAL CHARACTER?
