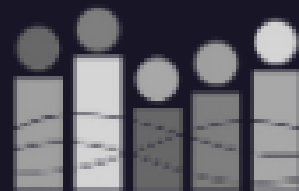

ADJUDICATOR AUTOBIOGRAPHY

I was born in the United Kingdom in the Cotswolds and spent the early part of my life there. I attended a boys' technical high school that specialised in woodwork, metalwork and engineering drawing. I had very observant teachers who noticed and nurtured my passion for the arts and in particular my ability to use my imagination to inject interest into my engineering work. I was encouraged to act in school plays, be involved in as much interschools activity as possible that allowed us to go and see many plays and musicals both locally and at The Royal Shakespeare Company in Stratford Upon Avon where Shakespeare was born. This encouraged a lifelong interest and career in the performing arts as an actor, singer, teacher and mentor.

I went to a world-famous British drama school called Bristol Old Vic Theatre School, and after I graduated I worked as an actor, singer dancer in the West End and many of the famous British repertory companies.

I came to Australia in 1980 (a very long time ago) to assist in the production of a British musical about Elvis Presley and loved Australia so much I decided to make it my home. Since officially becoming Australian I have appeared in supporting roles in many film and TV shows and acted and directed many plays and musicals on stage all over Australia. I have taught acting in Australia, New Zealand, America and the UK and continue to teach and encourage performers of all ages to be the best version of themselves they can be.
